Consultants' report on heating options – Executive Summary

This will be a major report, paid for by WCC, with the task of checking which works **must be done**, as opposed to those that **could be done**. There is a delay: does the latest contract carry enough scope?

 - Find out which are for carers
 - Find out which are for rentals
 - Write to rentals and push them to relinquish their safe.
 - Then, if necessary forced removal

Use of the Grounds

Discussion on access to grounds and block. The meeting took a strong line on not allowing access.

- The grounds only for residents with accompanying guests. No parties or socials or outsiders' dogs
- The meeting room only for LTRA business, except:
 - WCC housing staff holding surgeries with residents (maybe one afternoon a month) – detail to be worked up
